A RESOLUTION

Requesting His Excellency David W. Panuelo President of the Federated States of Micronesia to include participation and involvement of delegates of the Fourth Constitutional Convention in educating the citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia on the proposed constitutional amendments adopted by the Fourth Constitutional Convention of the Federated States of Micronesia.

1            WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XIV, Section 2 of the  
2 Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia, in March of  
3 2019, a majority of the citizens of the Federated States of  
4 Micronesia voted "yes" to the question "Shall there be a  
5 convention to revise or amend the Constitution?"; and

6            WHEREAS, pursuant to the enabling statute, Public Law 21-19,  
7 the Fourth Constitutional Convention of the Federated States of  
8 Micronesia convened on January 7, 2020, in Palikir, Pohnpei, to  
9 consider proposed amendments to the FSM Constitution, and the  
10 Convention anticipates that it will propose one or more amendments  
11 to the Constitution; and

12            WHEREAS, Public Law 21-19, Section 8(1) requires that the  
13 amendments approved by the Convention shall be voted on in a  
14 referendum to be held in March 2021 or earlier in a referendum  
15 called by the FSM President if one or more of the proposals will  
16 effect the general election; and

17            WHEREAS, it is important that the citizens of the FSM be  
18 appropriately educated about the proposed amendments to the

11 Chief Justice of the Kosrae State Court; the Honorable Nelson  
12 Joseph Chief Justice of the Pohnpei State Court; the Honorable  
13 Cyprian Manmaw Chief Justice of the Yap State Court; and to the  
14 President and officers of the Fourth Constitutional  
15 Convention of the Federated States of Micronesia.
