A PROPOSAL

Relating to amending the Constitution.

	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:
1	Section 1 of Article XIV. An amendment to this Constitution
1	Section 1 of Afticle XIV. An amendment to this constitution
2	may be proposed by a constitutional convention, popular
3	initiative, or Congress in a manner provided by law. A proposed
4	amendment shall become a part of the Constitution when approved by
5	2/3 of the votes cast on that amendment in each of $3/4$ of the
6	states. If conflicting constitutional amendments submitted to the
7	voters at the same election are approved, the amendment receiving
8	the highest number affirmative votes shall prevail to the extent
9	of such conflict.
